There have been sports clubs provided for the children in after-school provision. There have been 2 clubs per half term and this has been for KS1 and KS2 children, ensuring the children have been given a range of clubs this year.

How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?

The number of clubs that have been provided for the children to take part in has increased. Also, the number of sports competitions at trust and local level has increased.

How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?

A HLTA has shown interest in developing their coaching approach and they achieved their Level 2 coaching award. Furthermore, they attended the PE conference to gain more information about PE in Primary Schools. We have also linked up with a local school to develop PE teaching approaches.

How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?

The children in Y6 were provided with additional lessons if they weren't able to swim 25m. The children that attended made good progress and this reduced the number of non-swimmers in the cohort. There was also a water safety provision included.

How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?

The children in year 6 were given a water safety session as part of extra provision. They also attended a Hope UK workshop which included a session about water safety from the fire department.

How is your school going to ensure that the improvements made through its spending of the PE and sport premium are sustainable?

There will be a continued allocation of the grant to CPD of staff to ensure PE lessons develop allowing an enriched PE curriculum to be provided. There will also be money used to ensure PE competitions are attended locally and within the trust so that children have the opportunity to compete against other schools. The school will link with other schools to develop opportunities which will continue to enhance the provision at school.
